1. Alton, Hampshire
Brick: Jane Austen's House; Chawton Hall
2. Blackheath, London
Brick: Vanburgh's Castle; Ranger's House in Greenwich Park; All Saints church
3. Cardiff
Brick: Pierhead Building
4. Guildford
Brick: Guildford Cathedral; Abbot's Hospital (C17 almshouses)
5. Harpenden, Hertfordshire
Brick: Rothamsted House (C17 brick house); buildings in the town (early C20)
6. Ingatestone Hall, Essex
Brick: Ingatestone Hall (late C16 brick house)
7. Layer Marney Hall, Essex
Brick: Layer Marney Hall (C16 brick house) Layer Marney church (terracotta tombs)
8. Ludlow, Shropshire
Brick: Main street of C18 brick houses
9. Marlborough, Wiltshire
Brick: Marlborough School; buildings in town
10. Newport, Gwent
Brick: Tredegar House (C17 brick house)
11. Peterborough
Brick: Last remaining Fletton brickworks at Whittlesey
12. St Albans, Hertfordshire
Brick: Cathedral (reused Roman brick; new chapter house); Roman Verulamium; Marlborough almshouses
13. Salisbury, Wiltshire
Brick: Cathedral Close (C17 and later houses)
14. Tilbury, Essex
Brick: Tilbury Forts (C16 and C19 brick military installations)
