
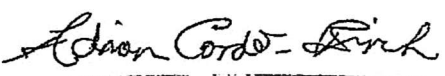

NOTES TO ACCOUNTS (GJP)

- 1 Loss for the year primarily because 25 subs still coming in at pre-2022 rates despite reminders from the Chairman which equates to a £200+ shortfall
- 2 The costs per issue of *Information* are ever increasing and the new regime of larger but one less issue per annum continues to be beneficial to the Society's finances
- 3 Membership numbers have fallen again
- 4 Despite the subscriptions issue and the effects of inflation, the Society's finances are in relatively good health
